PURPOSE:

The purpose of this SIP is to test a curriculum designed to increase the quality of relationships of low-income, unmarried parents. Between 90 and 100 percent of the participants studied were African American. Twenty-eight couples completed the curriculum. The curriculum is the result of collaboration between Smart Marriages and Survival Skills of Healthy Families. The project will be extended so the grantee can complete their analysis and evaluation.
